

# BCSC 2024 PROM GUIDELINES

## WHO is eligible to attend the Prom?

1. Any junior or senior enrolled in good standing in Columbus East, Columbus North or CSA New Tech High School is eligible to attend. (Must be at least a Jr. at beginning of 23-24 school year)
2. A **GUEST** of a North, East or CSA junior or senior may attend if he or she meets the following requirements:
  - ✓ Is registered in the Cohort Office prior to the Prom

**AND**

  - ✓ Has reached at least junior or senior status in the high school he or she attends or has attended. (Must be at least a Jr. at beginning of 23-24 school year.)

**AND**

  - ✓ Must be younger than the age of 21 on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024

**AND**

  - ✓ Must be in good standing.

**Each guest is subject to review for eligibility by the Administration. It is understood that the host student is responsible for the actions and behavior of his or her guest while attending the Prom.**

## WHEN is the Prom?

9:00pm – 12:00am the evening of Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024

## WHERE is the Prom?

The Commons. The downtown entrance will be on Washington street, between 3rd and 4th streets.

## WHAT must I have to be admitted to Prom?

1. Each person must have a ticket. Tickets may be purchased in the CEHS/CNHS Bookstore or CSA MPR for \$22.00 per person. All tickets will be checked at the door: **NO ONE WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT A TICKET.**
2. Each North, East & CSA student must present a **school I.D.** at the door. Also each guest should present a **Picture I.D.** to enter and must be registered at the time of ticket purchase.

## How must I dress for Prom?

Dress is formal. (This means suits, tuxedos, or formal dresses are required.) For example: NO jeans, t-shirts, corduroy material, clothing with wording, or tennis shoes. If you have questions, please talk to your administration or prom coordinator before the Prom. Administration will decide the appropriateness of any questionable dress.

## If I have a question, whom do I ask for an answer?

Remember that because this is a school activity, all school rules and policies are in effect. Refer any additional questions to the Cohort Office.

## Where can I park for Prom?

Students can park in any legal street parking downtown, including the two parking garages (one across from YES Cinema and the Post Office and the other a block down off of 3<sup>rd</sup> street).

## PLEASE NOTE:

Even though this year's prom is based around characters, **NO STUDENT** will be permitted if they dress in full costume, are wearing a mask, are carrying a light saber, etc. Only those approved character actors will be admitted in costume.
